### Pledge to Allegiance

Supervisor turned floor over to Cathi Radner Town Attorney and William  
Ball Code Enforcement Officer for discussion on the on three citations that  
have been issued under the Unsafe Structure Law. The Code Enforcement  
Officer has spoken to the three residents and they have assured him that they  
will be taking action on their properties. If action is not taken there's a  
document form we can use to further enforce the situation.

Two more property owners are in the process of being sited.

The Siminage property on Creek Road cannot be verified without going into  
residence. They have placed many bags of garbage on the porches which  
would call rodents. In this case the Board can act as the Board of Health.

The St. Andrews property at the corner of Pearl Street and Creek Road also  
is another property to be reviewed.

If residents refuse to obey Code Enforcement Officer he will come back to  
the Board. Then the Board makes the decision on what is to follow.

Ms. Radner informed the Board there are alternative actions that can be  
followed in all cases to solve correct situations.

Mazurowski made the motion to authorize Supervisor permission to sign the agreement between Essex County Public Health Department to create a Community Garden with \$5,000.00 grant from NYS Department of Health for "Creating Healthy Places to Live and Play."
