

The Town of Crown Point held a Public Hearing Thursday March 22, 2018

Supervisor called Public Hearing to order at 6:00 PM

Supervisor explained the purpose of the Public Hearing upon a certain map, plan and report, including an estimate of cost, in relation to the proposed increase and improvement of the facilities of the Crown Point Sewer District, in Crown Point construction of a new wastewater treatment system to be located at Station Street and Monitor Bay Road at the site of the old railroad depot and adjacent property in Crown Point, New York, together with related auxiliary facilities, including original furnishings, equipment, machinery, appurtenances, land or rights-in-land and incidental improvements and expenses in connection therewith at a maximum estimated cost of \$4,829,509.25.

The capital project described above has been determined to be a "Type II Action" pursuant to the regulations promulgated under State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQRA") due to an order on Consent with the Department of Environmental Conservation which it has been determined, pursuant to 6 NYCRR Part 617.5(5)(29) thereof, will not result in any significant environmental adverse effects. Copies of SEQRA compliance materials, the order on consent and the map plan and report are available in the office of the Town Clerk, where they may be inspected during regular office hours.

Supervisor explained the need for a Bond for the short term expenses, Engineering, surveys and land purchases. The amount to be \$4,829,509.25. Short term financing, Champlain National Bank will be the financier.

At present we have inability to function at NYS Standards. We are looking at a 2 year time frame. We have to have the Bond Resolution to receive Grants that will be applied toward the Town's loan.

Supervisor adjourned Public Hearing at 6:35PM.
