C. Barrows made the motion to schedule an informational meeting November 29,  
2022 at the Crown Point Central Auditorium for persons within the Waste Water  
District informing them of the plans to construct an Ultra Violet System which will  
remove chlorine from the Waste Water District effluent before it enters the lake  
and the rehabilitation of pump stations. The Waste Water District currently does
